Standing in Box-A, facing downrange, hands relaxed at sides. Gun loaded & holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon Start Signal, draw & engage T1 thru T4 with two rounds each from each shooting box.

SCORED HITS

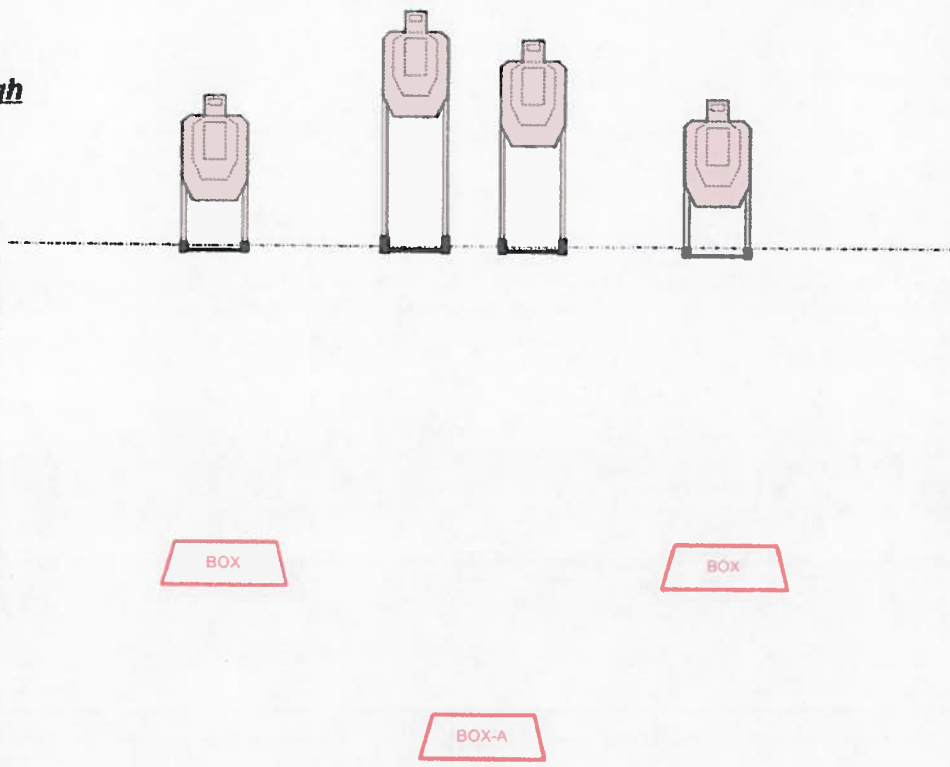

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Crow Carter — Modifications by US Design Team

START POSITION: Standing in Box A, hands naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On the signal, engage T1-T6 with one round maximum freestyle, perform a mandatory reload, then reengage T1-T6 with one round maximum, strong hand only.

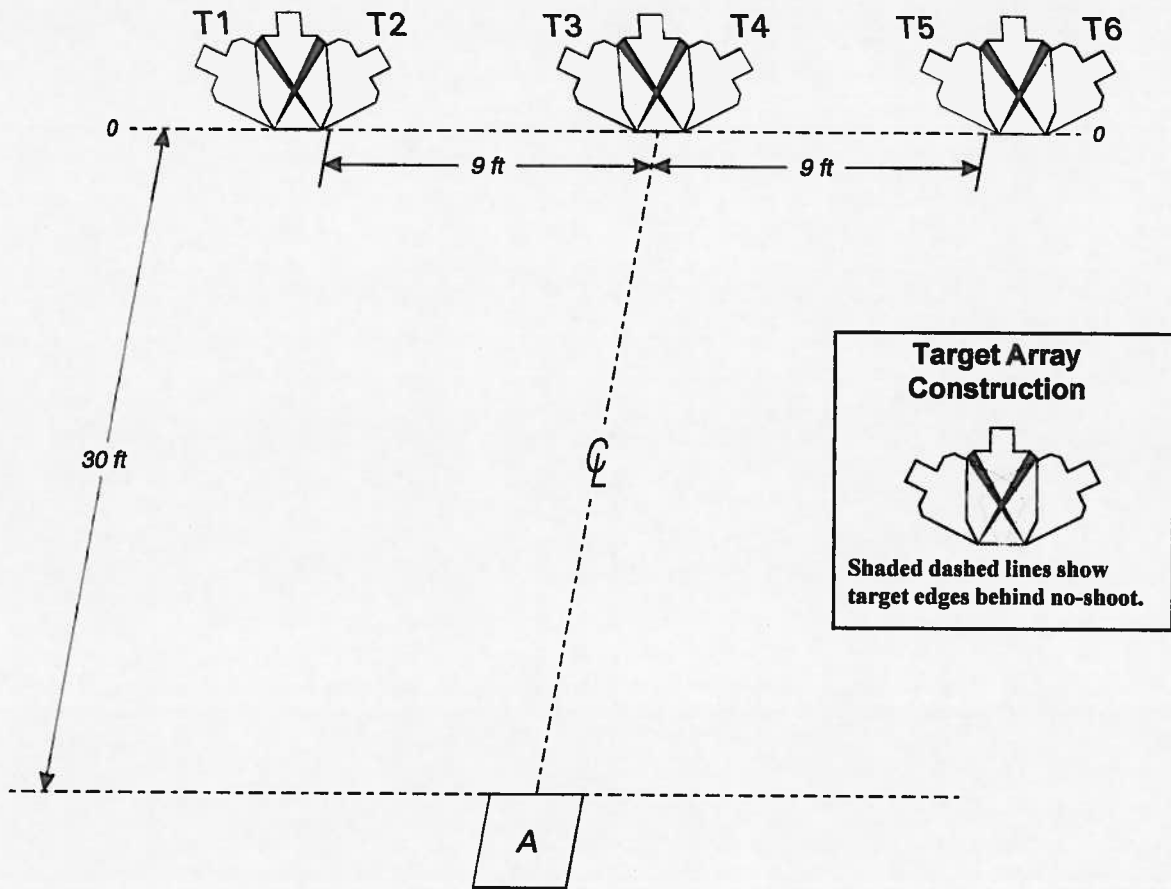
SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points

TARGETS: 6 Metric

SCORED HITS: Best 2/Paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last Shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules



SETUP NOTES: Set no-shoots to 4 feet high at top of B-zone. Build target arrays so that the upper corner of the waist meets the lower corner of the no-shoot,



with the short angled waist parallel to the bottom of the no-shoot.
